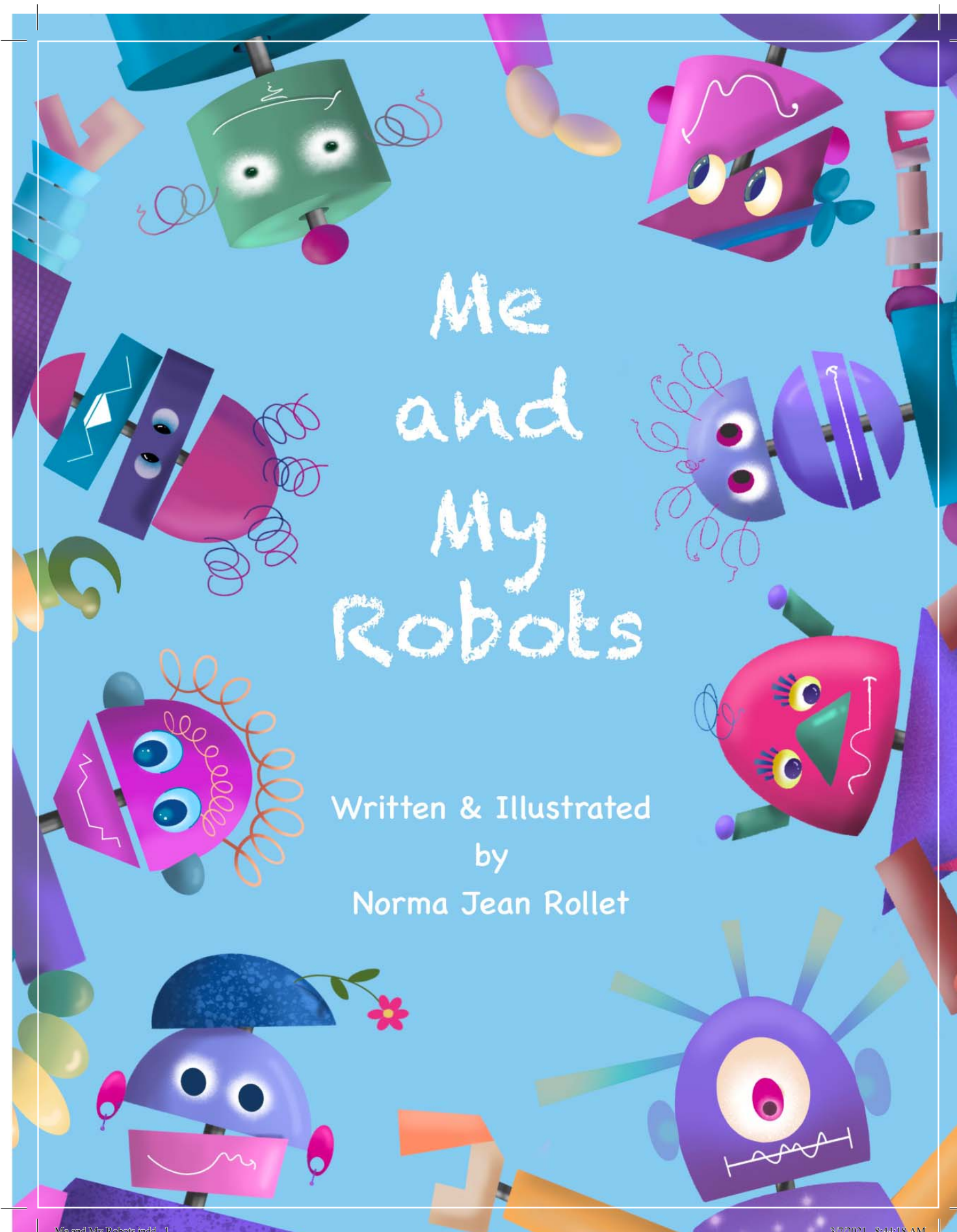

to help with this chore.

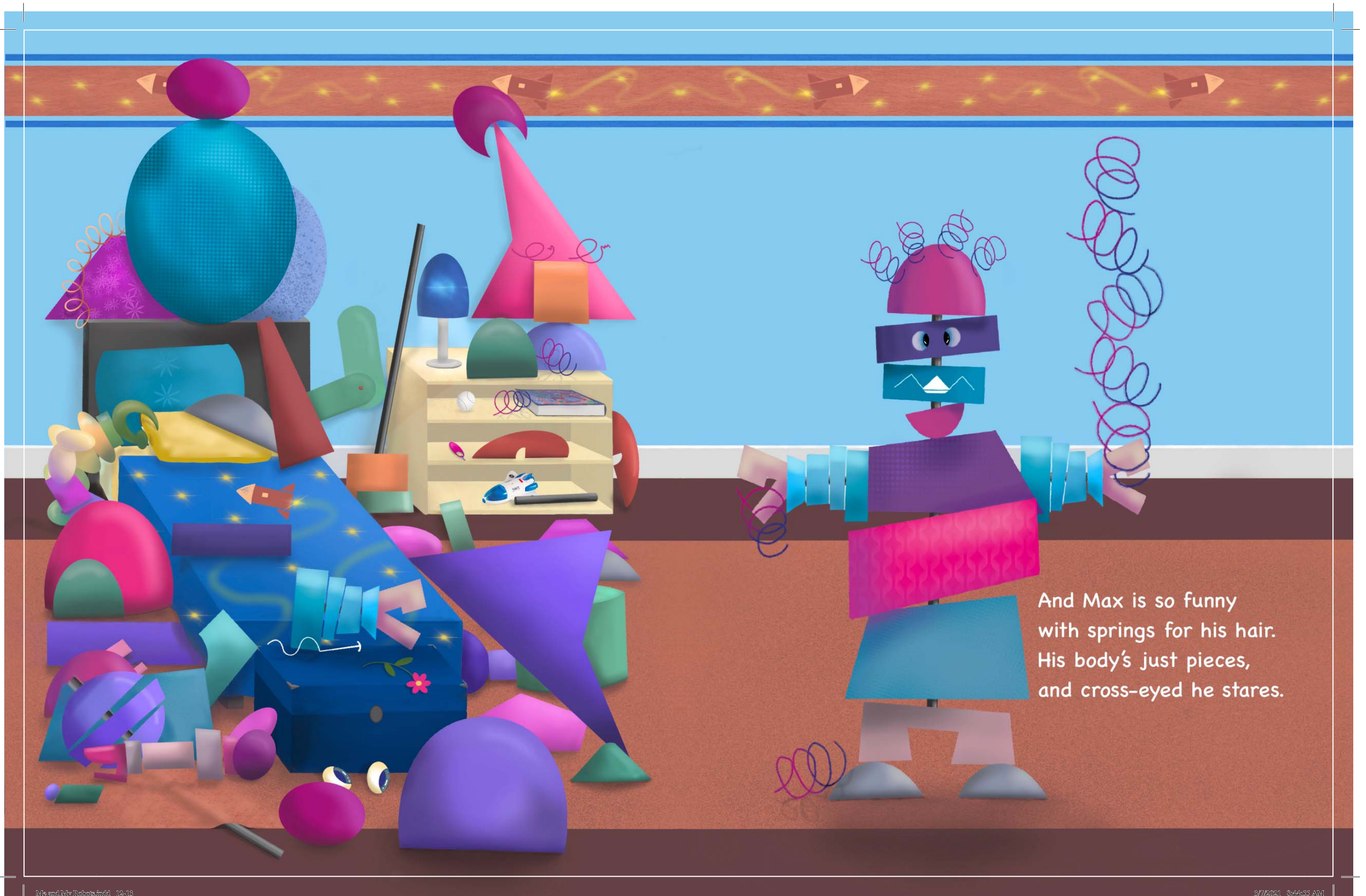
I'll take different pieces

all my clever bot helpers?

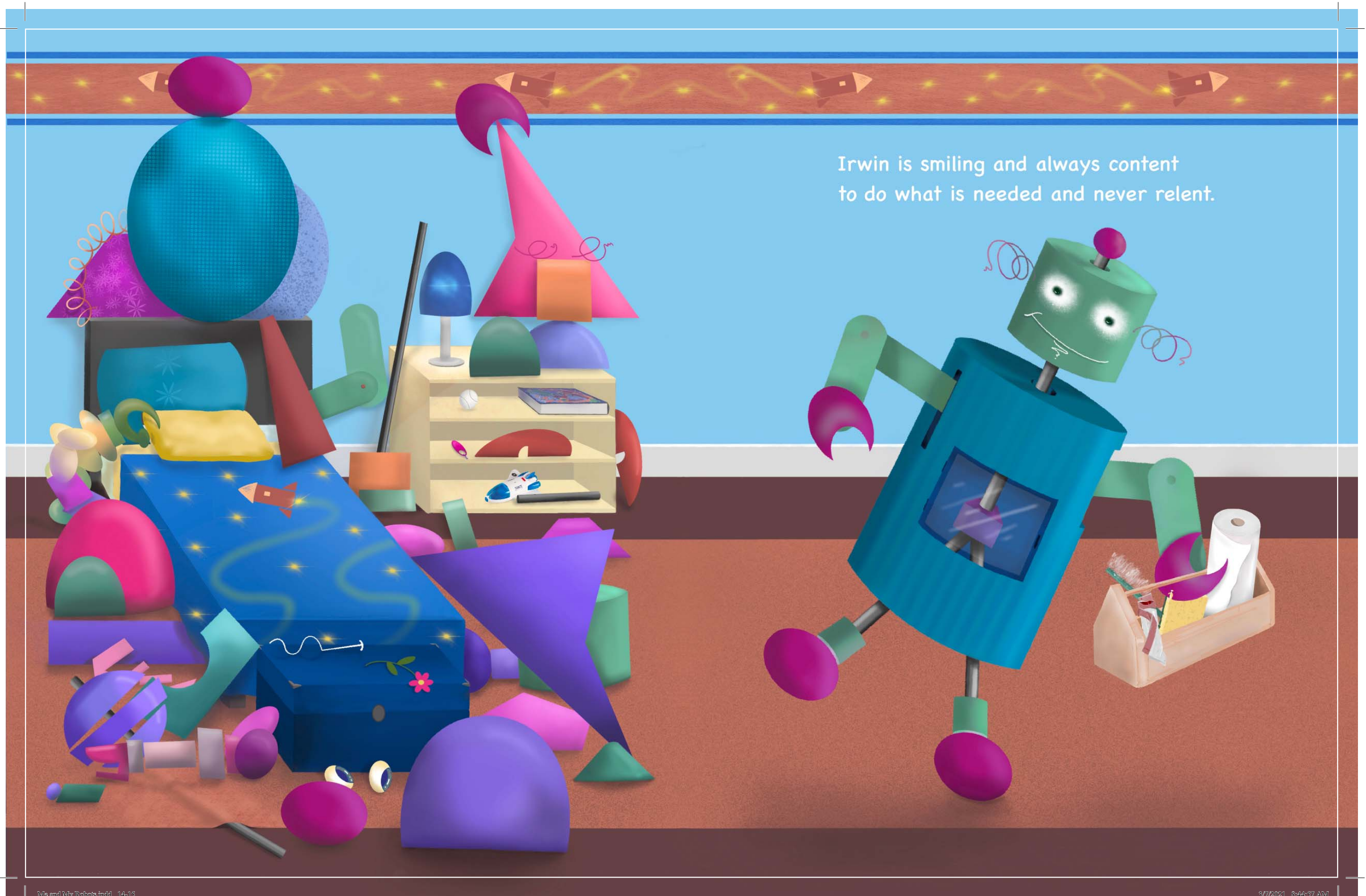


The first bot's named Alvin

and really quite shy.

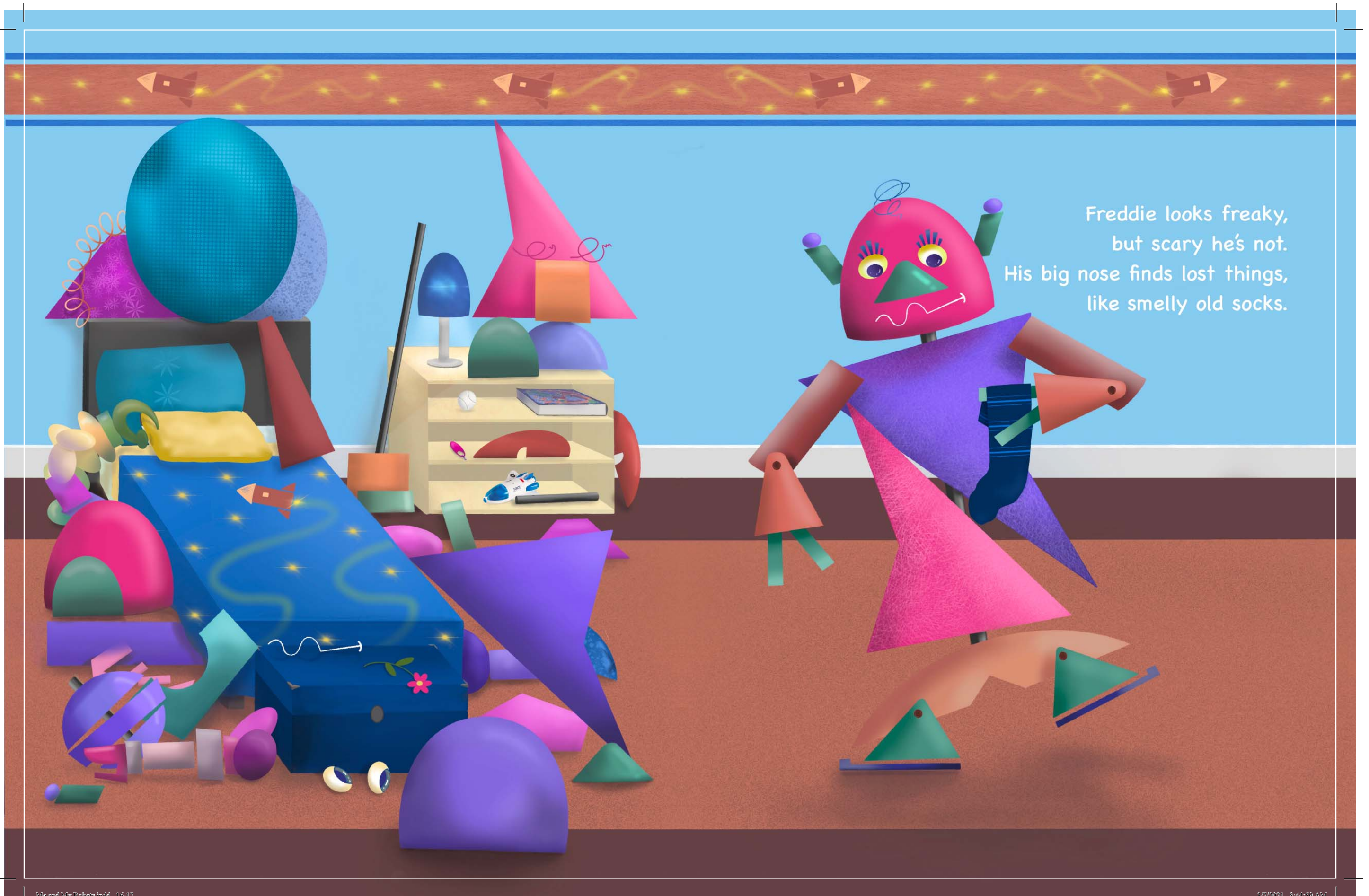




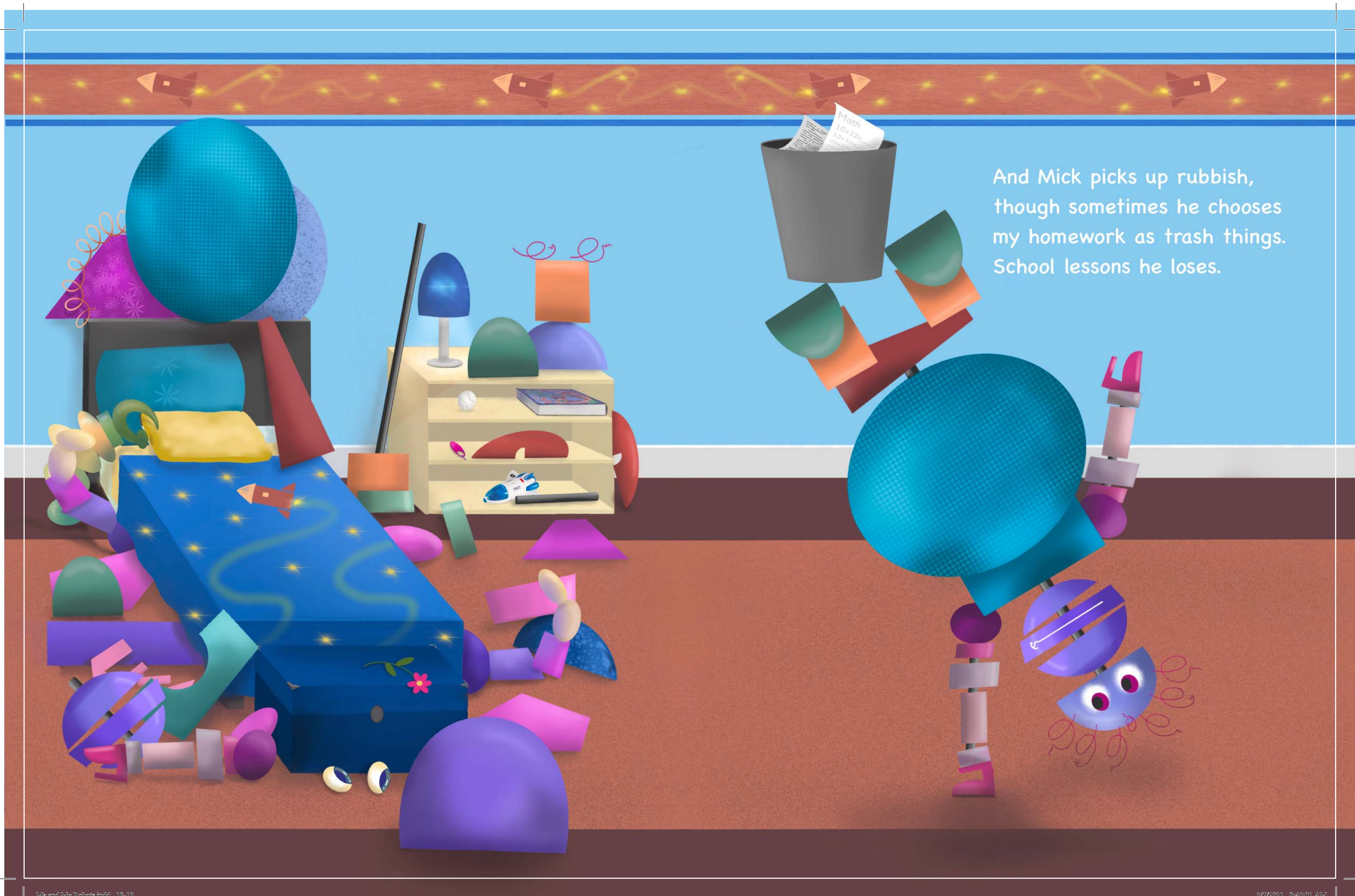
And Max is so funny

to do what is needed and never relent.



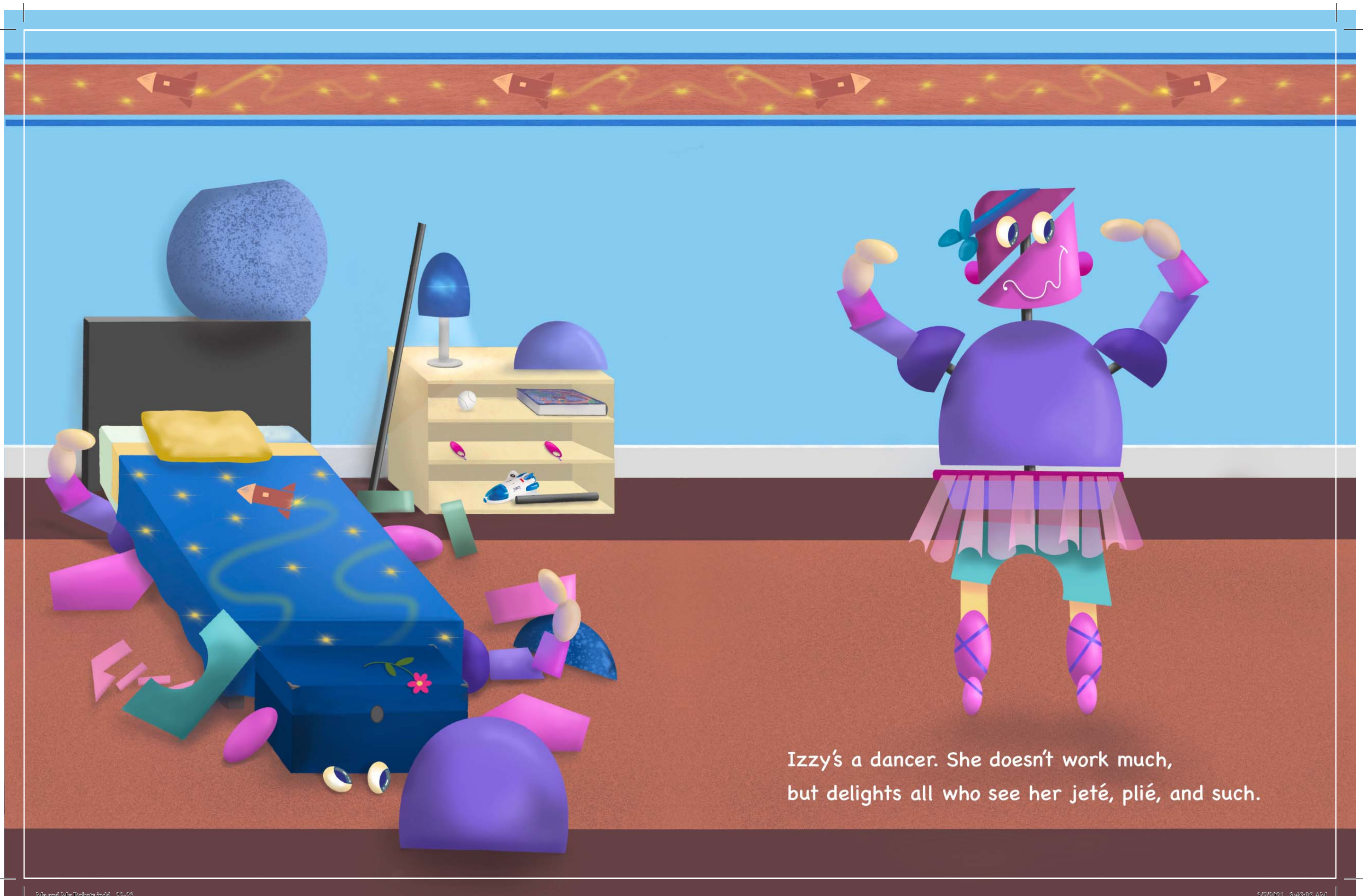
Freddie looks freaky,

She's thorough and bright.

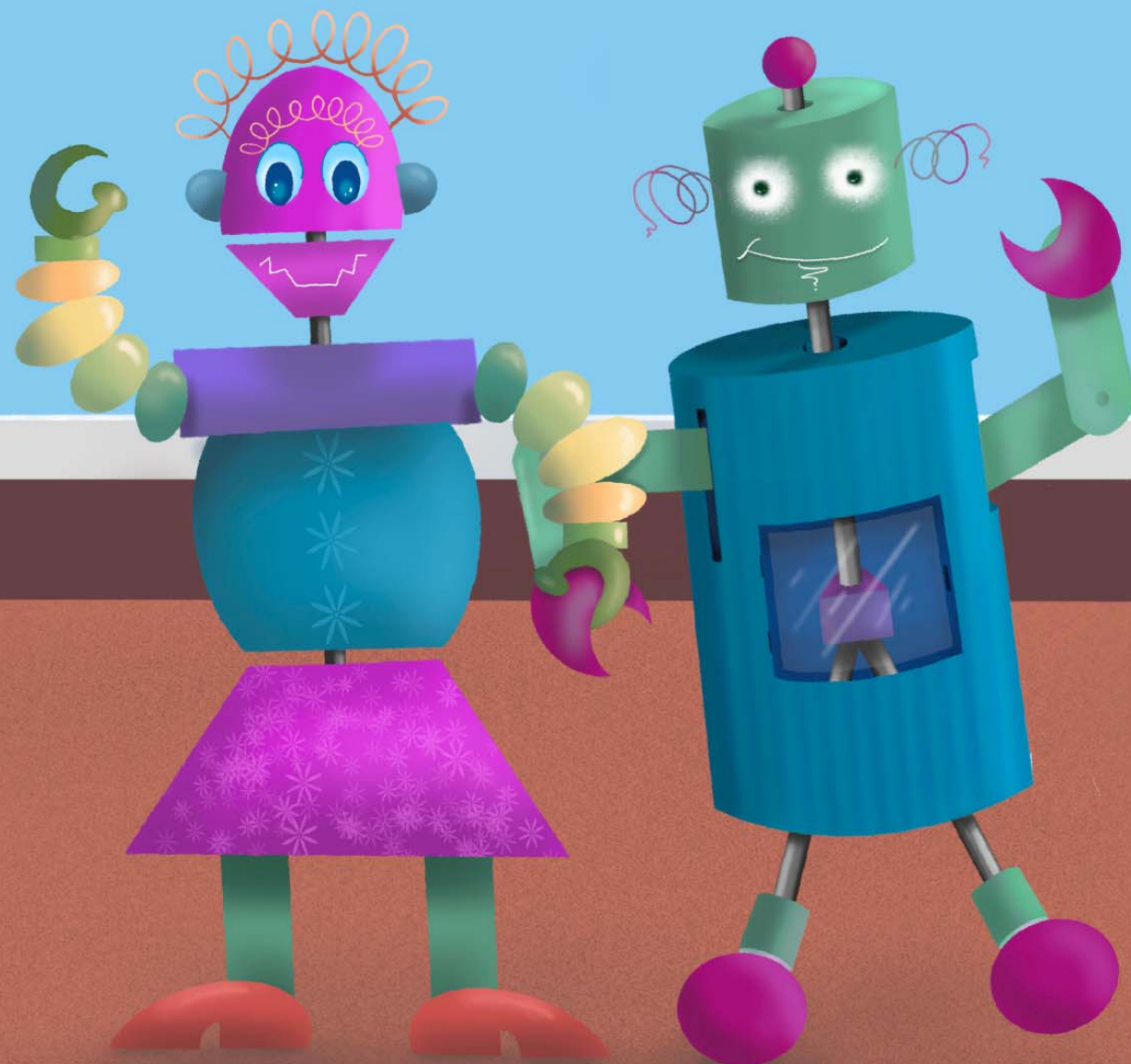
Chores
