But things took it over not sure what to do.



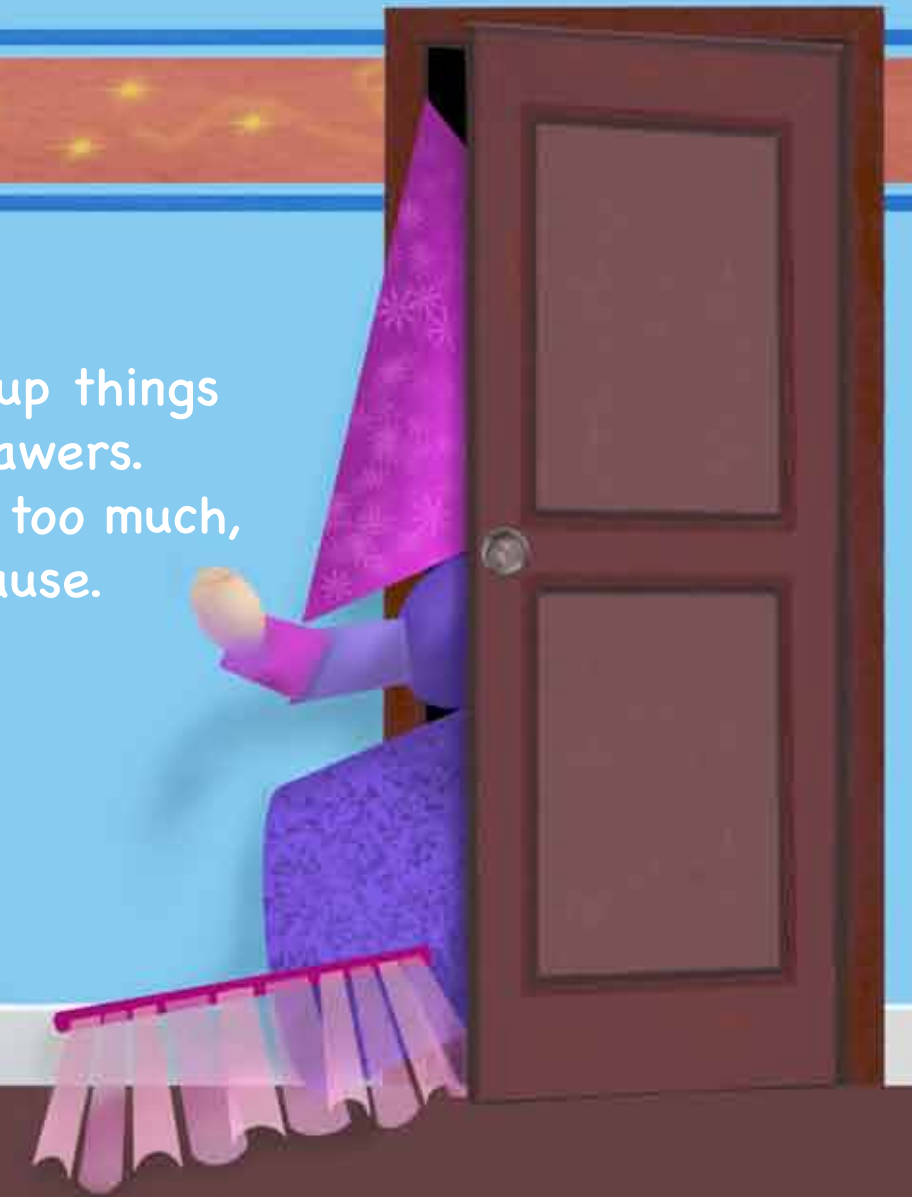
Now I am in trouble. My mom is upset.

there just is no space

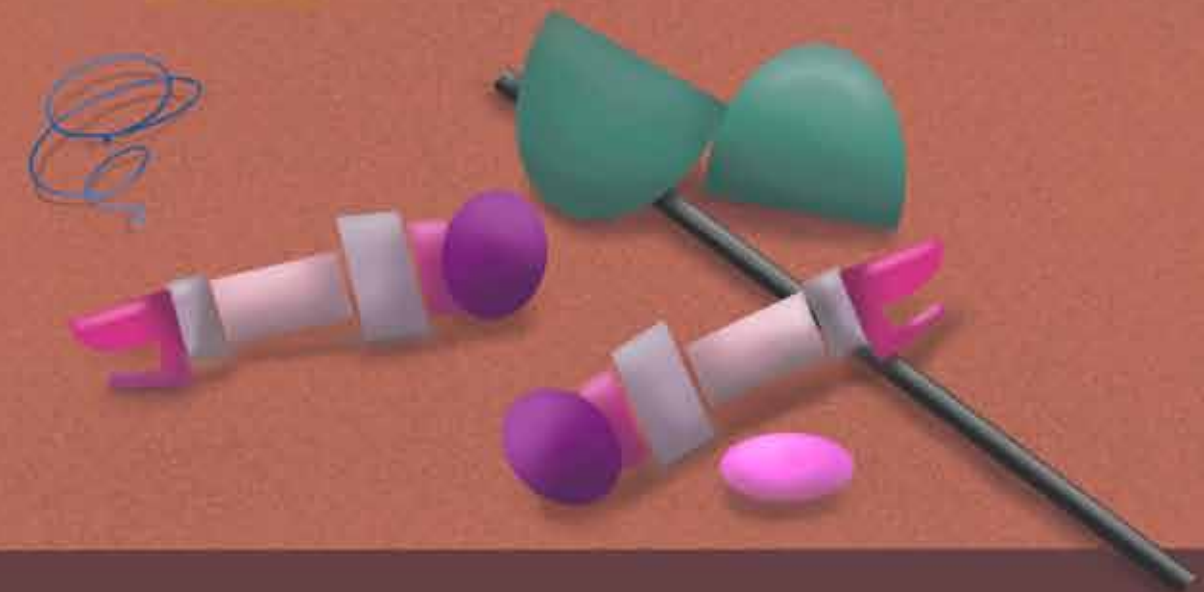




I tried stacking up things

my mom will allow.





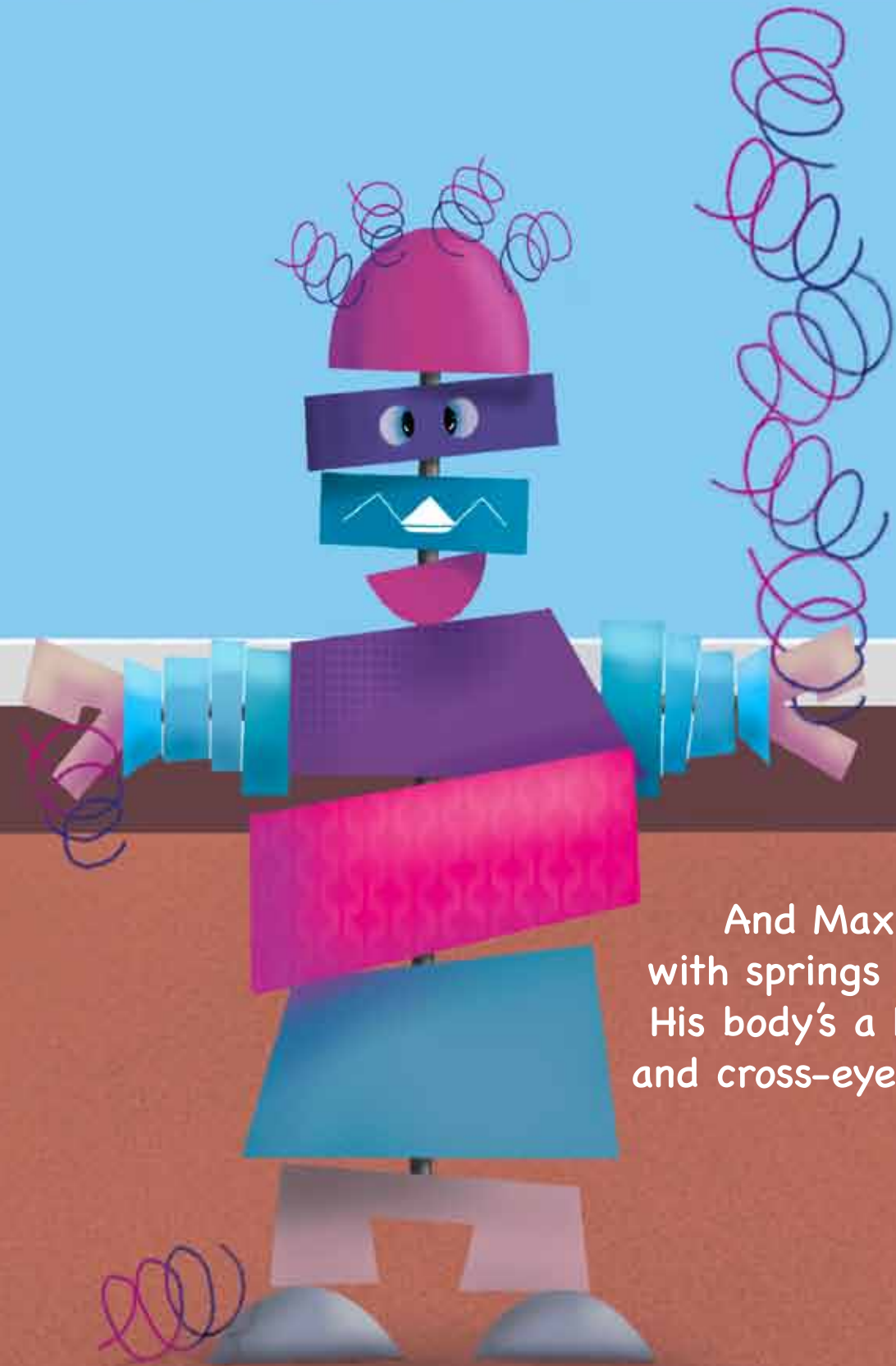
Can you find the pieces

He's purple with sparkles and really quite shy.

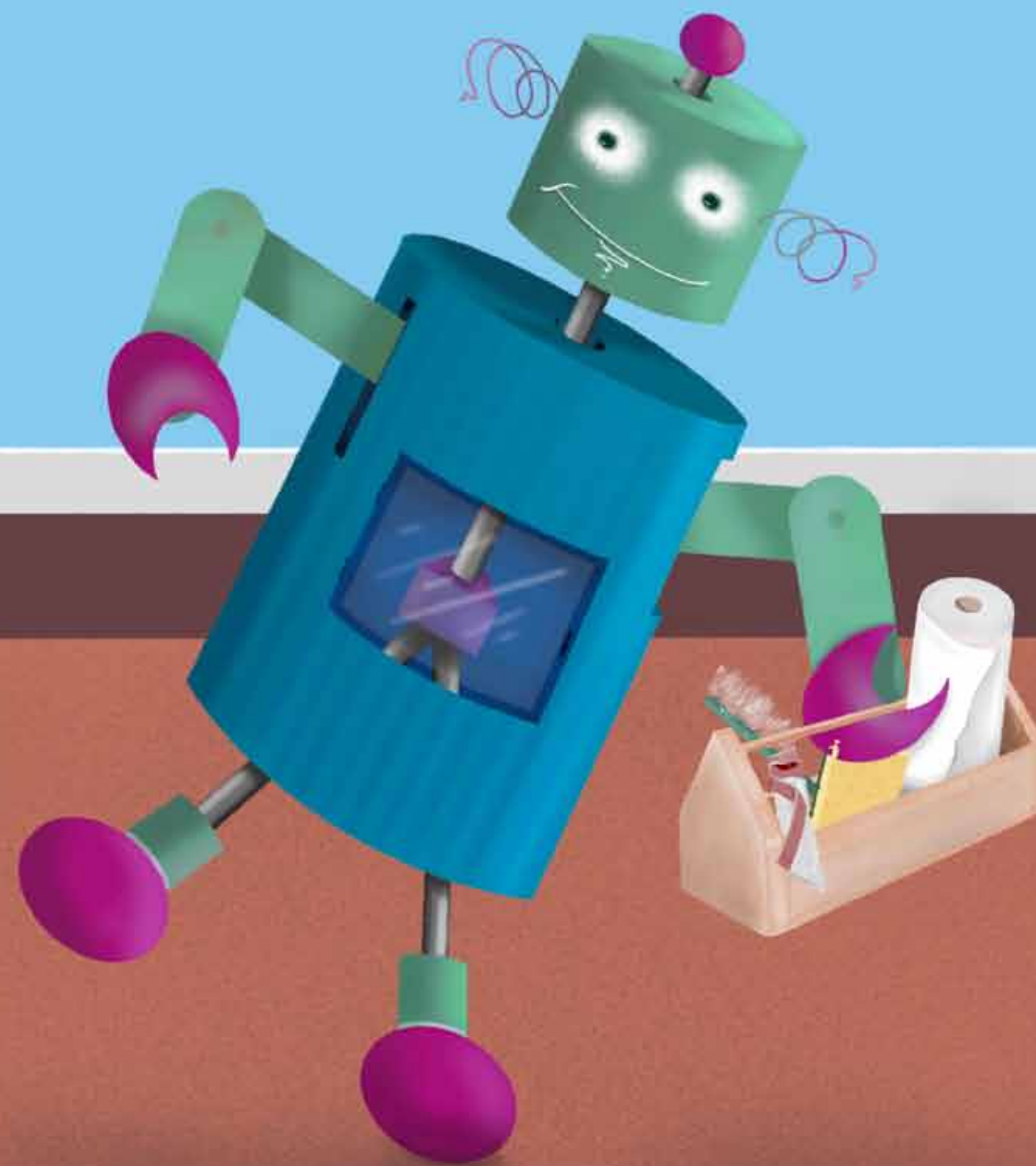


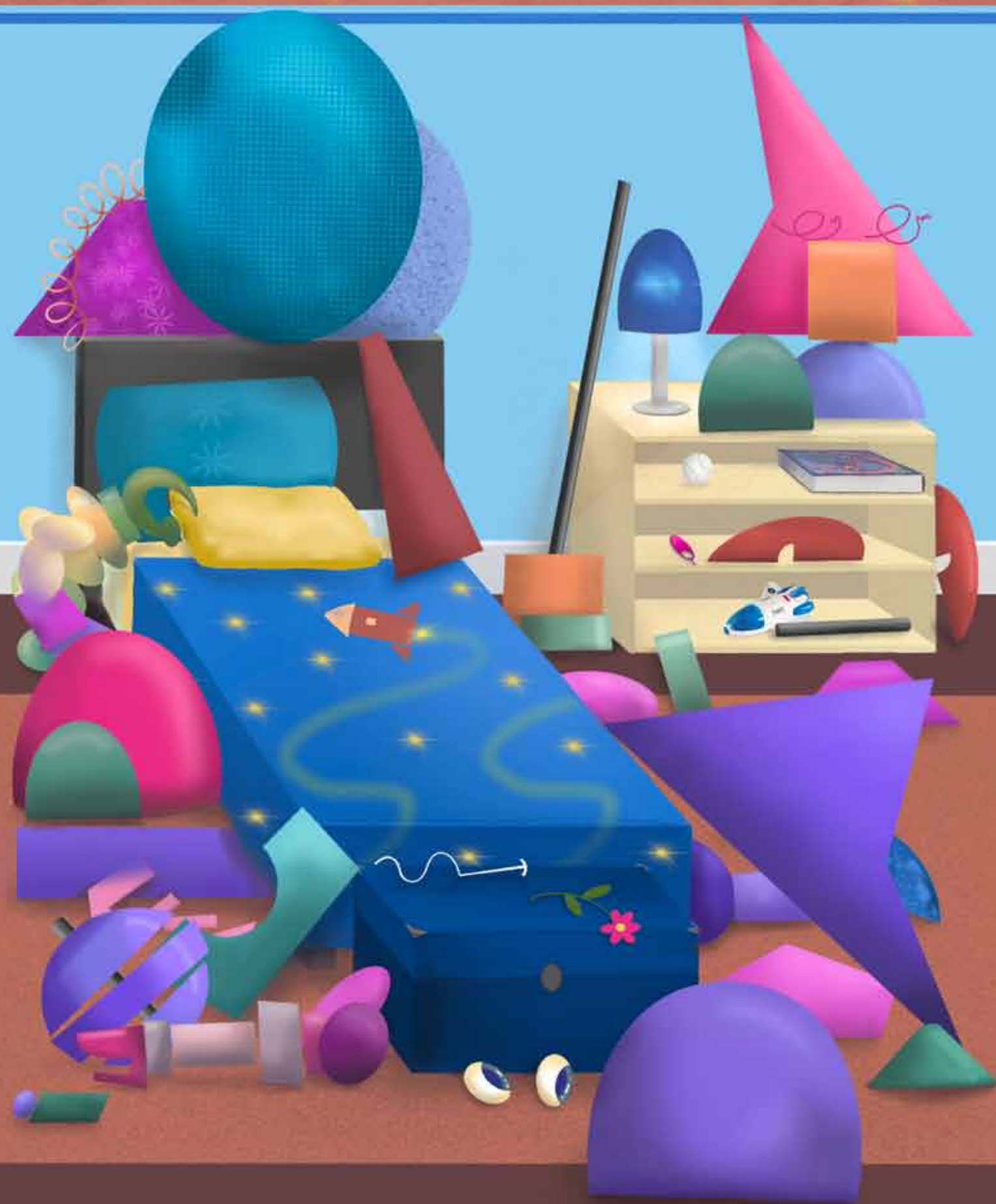


And Max is so funny

and cross-eyed he stares.



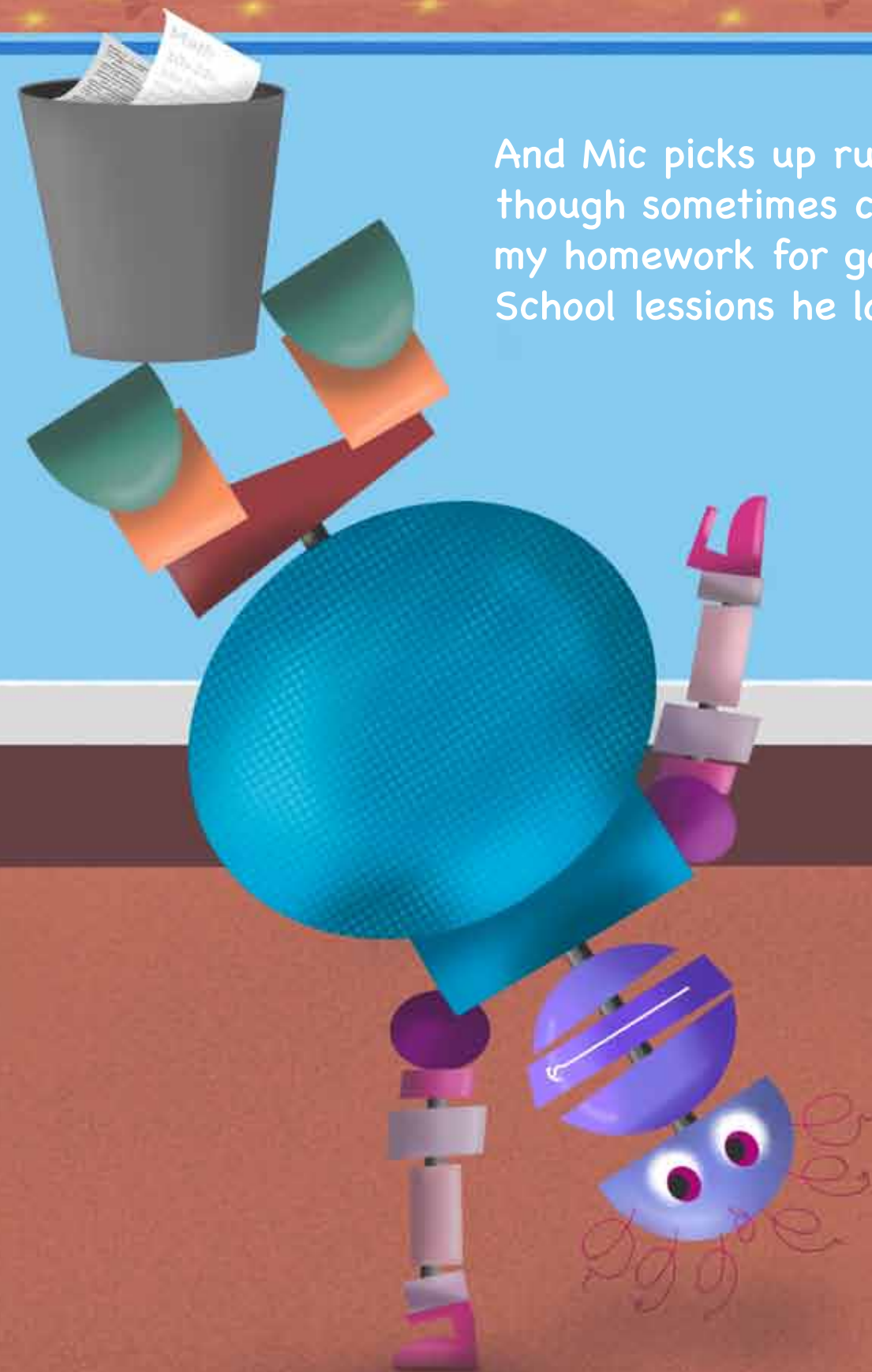
There also is Irwin who's always content,

School lessons he loses.

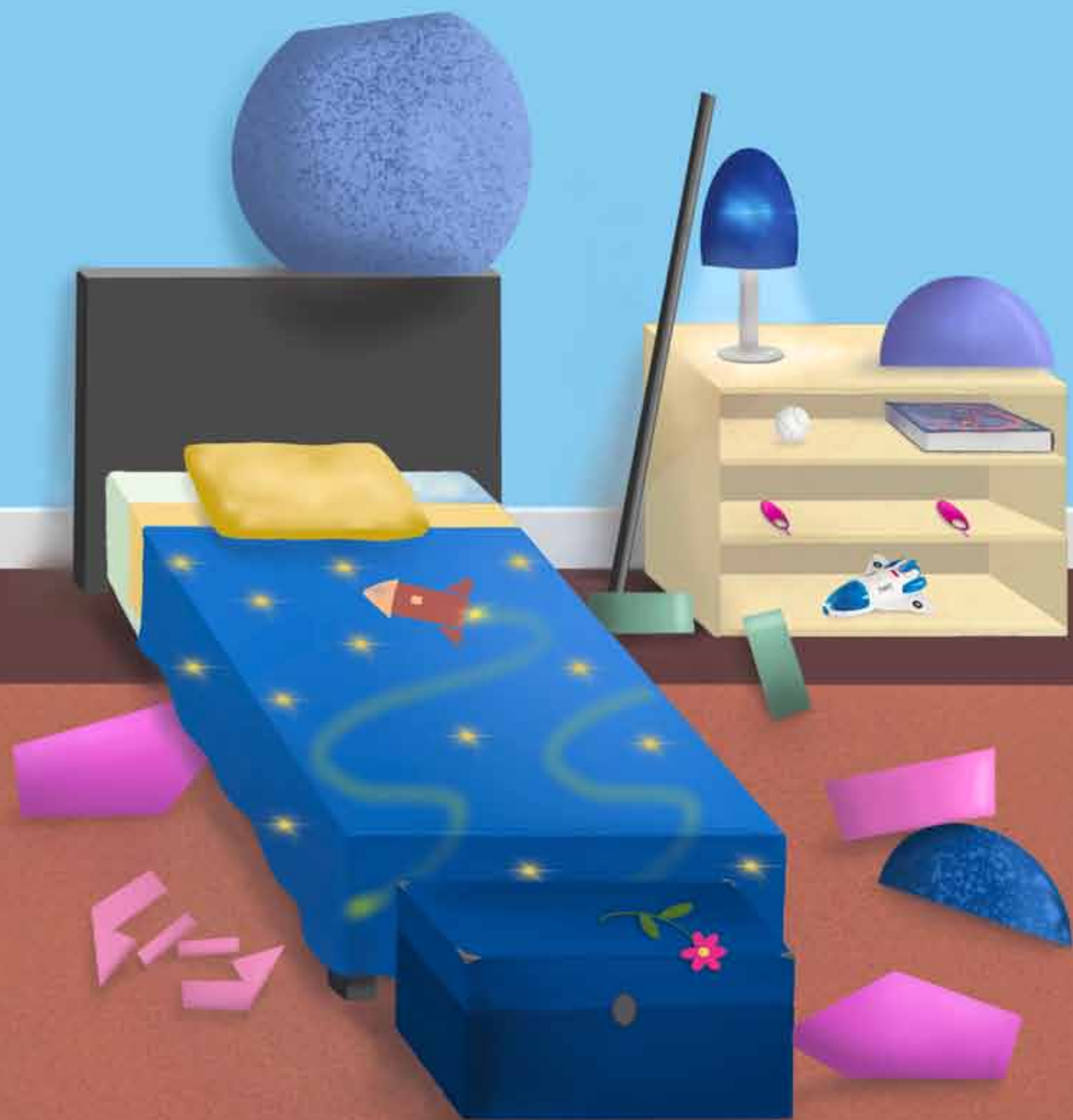


Sweet Lilly loves helping. She'll make beds and dust.

she's thorough and bright.

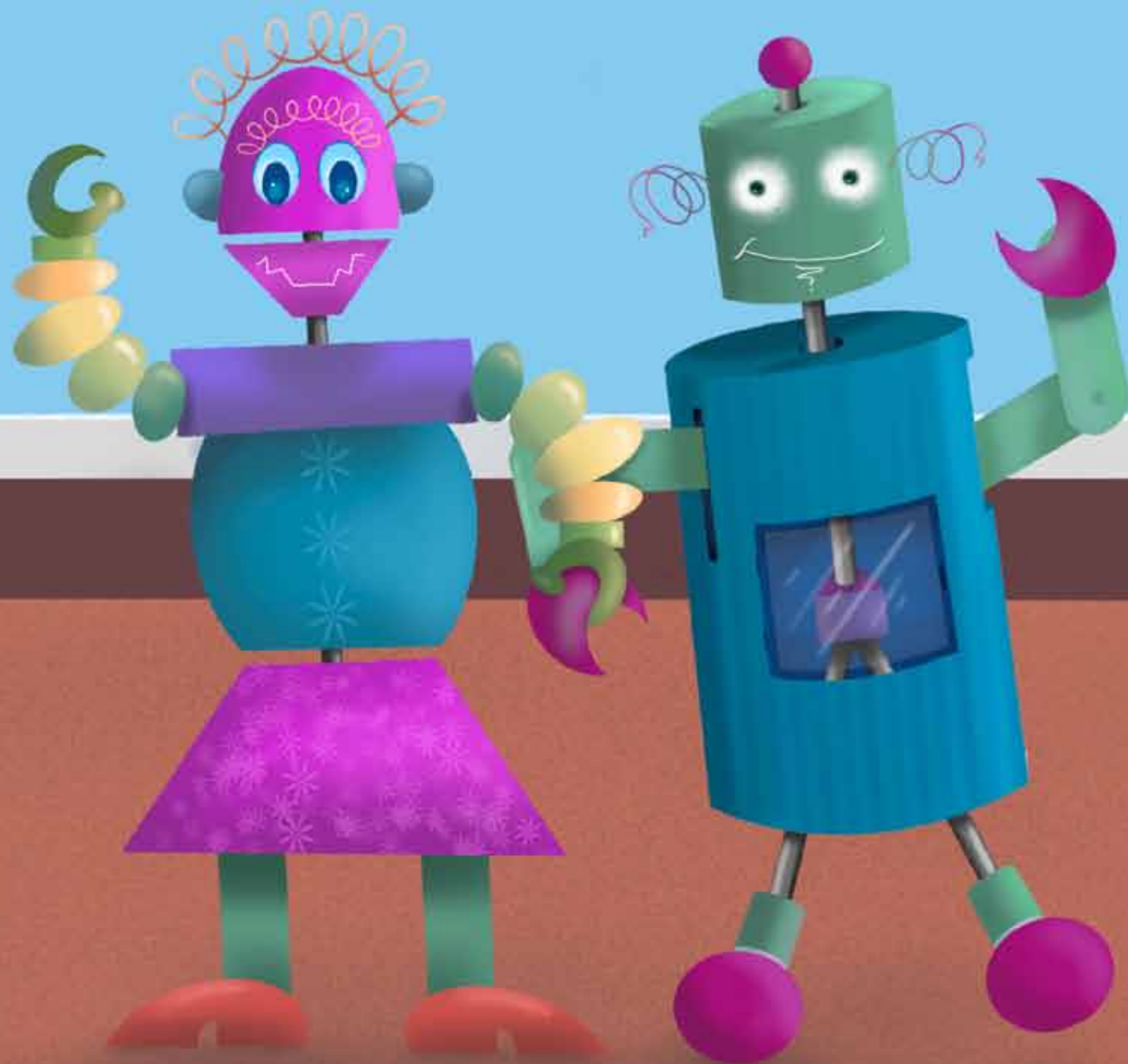


My mom is now smiling,

when chores are all done?

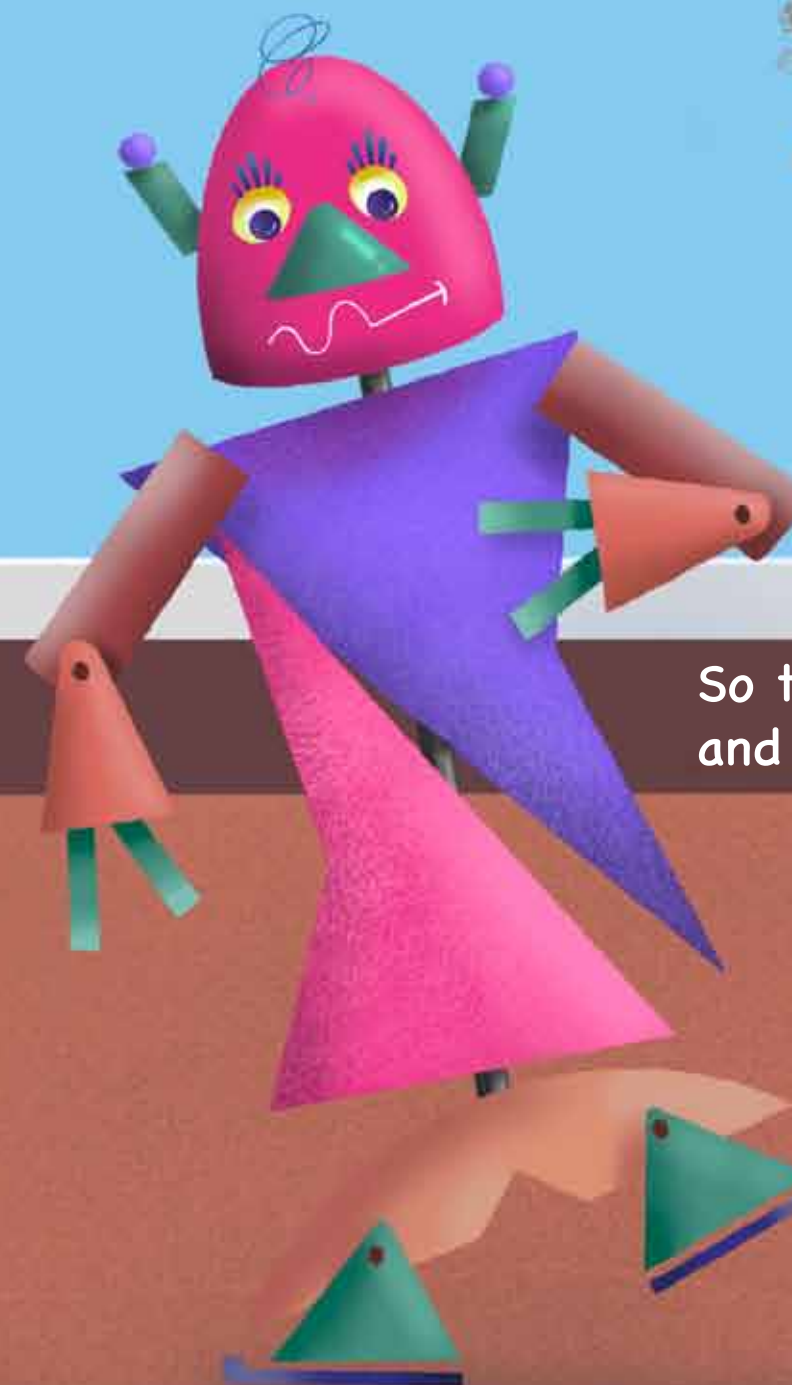
I'll give mom first option
